8. <u>Review of Rules</u>. Proposal received from Doug Collier, seconded by Louise Collier.

Over the years the Club's rules have been changed and I feel that some more changes are now necessary.

Rule 8, Para C was changed in 1991 and the word 'postal' was added due to the National and international spread of membership – changing the wording 'filled at the AGM by means of a ballot' to 'by means of a postal ballot.' Also in 1991 the timescale for nominations was changed from 7 days to 6 weeks. This whole paragraph is ambiguous as it appears to refer only to the committee of 21. The 'All vacancies' sentence should be reset separately to apply to Officers and Committee.

Proposal Rule 8, para C The 'All vacancies....' section to be removed from Para C and a new Para C1 to be created to read – All Officer and Committee vacancies to be filled at the AGM by means of a ballot. Nominations to be in the hands of the secretary four weeks prior to the AGM.

Proposal Rule 14. New Rules. The timing of the proposition/amendment to be changed back to what was in the original rules to read at least 28 days (not 6 weeks) and the notice to members 14 days (not 28 days).

Proposal Rule 12, para c. Notice of the AGM to be changed (from 8 weeks) to 28 days. (NB it was originally 14 days until changed in 1991.)

Proposal Rule 18 (about Club lapel badges) to be totally omitted and a new Rule 18 introduced –Postal ballot- All members unable to attend an AGM or a Special AGM are entitled to a postal vote on issues which will be counted at the meeting if received by the secretary 7 days prior to the meeting.

Rule 16b) The Club membership shall vote to select two judges for the Club Championship and Open breed shows from its own current judging lists....

Proposal 16b) The Club Committee shall vote to select judges for its shows – two for its Championship Breed Show and one or two for its Open Breed Show from its own current judging lists. Once having judged at the Club's Championship or Open Breed show then that person to be excluded from selection for judging that sex at the Championship or Open Breed Show (whichever they judged) for at least five years.
