### Minor Puppy Dog (3,0)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Oliver's ARRODARE ROYAL APPROVAL

Very raw 6 month old. Level topline with good neck and well balanced head. He has a correct tail set and moved well. Will be nice to see him once fully mature. Best Puppy Dog and RBPIS.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Porter's KIRKWIND SHOOTING STAR

Another very raw puppy who needs to mature. Stronger in head than first place but still nicely balanced with well placed ears. He needs to settle on the move. Correct coat coming through well, another will be interested to see in the future.

### Puppy Dog (6,0)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Oliver's ARRODARE ROYAL APPROVAL

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Austin's MIRAJE FROZEN AGAIN FOR HYSTEPS (ai)

Very well presented young dog with good spring of rib and ample coat. Well balanced head with good stop and nice ears. He moved well with a level topline and correct tail set.

### Junior Dog (1,0)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Shahmatova's NASHDOM PUTTING ON THE STYLE JW

Nicely angulated with good topline and nice reach of neck. Good dark eye with pleasant head and ample stop. Correct coat although appeared to be dropping much of it. He moved well but could be moved faster to show rear drive.

### Yearling Dog (2,0)

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Lee's MASTER OF ILLUSION JW

Overall a very sound dog with ample coat, good angulation and a level topline. Nice masculine head showing good balance and a nice dark eye. He was very well handled, however it would be interesting to see him moved a little faster.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Pollard's JANBELL THE FORCE AWAKENS

Another nice male, well presented but lacking slightly in body and spring of rib although this should come with maturity. Slightly longer in loin but still well balanced with a smart outline. Moved well but needs to run straighter.

### Graduate Dog (2,0)

1<sup>st</sup> Austin's MIRAJE FROZEN AGAIN FOR HYSTEPS (AI)

2<sup>nd</sup> Kinton & Davis KINAWAY ALL IS SAID AND DONE FOR JACAMALIS JW

This young male moved well but with slightly too much enthusiasm which made it hard for him to settle on the move. He has a correct coat and nice topline with a good tail set. Longer in body than first place.

### Post Graduate Dog (5,0)

1<sup>st</sup> Beaumont's KANAMAREN TRICK OF THE TAIL AT BORDERBEAU JW

This is a lovely male who I was pleased to award Best Dog and RBIS. He is immaculately presented and showed extremely well with good enthusiasm. He has a lovely head with a good reach of neck leading in to good front angulation and a level topline. Nice spring of rib and enough loin with good angulation at the rear and a well turned stifle. He showed ample drive and ground coverage whilst moving and was a pleasure to judge.

2<sup>nd</sup> Walter's GOYTRE HIDING MY HEART

This is another nicely constructed male who moved well with good drive. He has lovely angulation front and rear and a nice head with good reach of neck. Just preferred overall head balance of first place.

3<sup>rd</sup> Chandler's RAZDA FAME AND FORTUNE

### Limit Dog (1,0)

1<sup>st</sup> Barwick's TOBERMORAY TALK OF THE TOWN JW

Nicely put together male with ample body and length of loin. He moved well however needs to move faster in order to show more reach and ground coverage. He is slightly squarer in outline and lacking a little in reach of neck. He was today lacking in coat.

### Open Dog (8,2)

1<sup>st</sup> Gregory's TONKORY KING OF THE ROAD JW

Very well handled, absolutely immaculately presented young dog. Strong movement front and rear, level topline and a correct head with good dark eye, nice stop and good ear set. Good angulation front and rear with lovely straight hocks.

2<sup>nd</sup> Large's SH CH WIZALAND SONGS FROM THE WOOD

Extremely close call between first and second place. This is another well-constructed male this time of stronger type with good angulation, nice reach of neck and a good correct coat. He moved very well and showed good drive but I felt he needed to settle on the move. It is a shame he came up against first place but they could very easily swap places.

3<sup>rd</sup> Harlow's SH CH SIMARO JAMES BOND JW (IMP DEU)

Any Other Colour Than Black & White (3,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Pollard's ARNPRIORS HARVEST GOLD

7 year old red with a nice coat of good quality and well presented. He has a good topline with nice angulation and moved well with great enthusiasm. Lovely straight hocks and well set tail. He most certainly enjoyed his day out.

2<sup>nd</sup> Knight's DREAMWORK SHADES OF GREY

This is a very overly excited blue merle who today was lacking in body and coat. He was so enthusiastic that it was extremely hard to judge his movement. Slightly lacking in front and rear angulation which prevents him from covering the ground well when he moves. If more settled he would be easier to judge.

Special Working Dog (3,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Barwick's TOBERMORAY TALK OF THE TOWN JW

2<sup>nd</sup> Brierley's GOYTRE FIRST EDITION P-BEG-EX

This was a close call between first and second place and I think if moved faster the two could have swapped places. He is a lovely male although I would prefer slightly more body which would assist him in looking a little more masculine. His angulation was good, and he moved well coming and going.

Veteran Dog (9,3)

1<sup>st</sup> Carley, Ward & MacFarlane's SH CH JUPAVIA SEVENTH HEAVEN JW SHCM

Superbly presented and well handled mature dog who was full of enthusiasm. He has a lovely outline with a balanced head, ample reach of neck and correct front angulation. His topline is level on the stand and move, correct tail set and he covers ground well when he moves. Pleased to award Reserve Best Dog, BVD and RBVIS.

2<sup>nd</sup> Gowing's WILDBLUE IT'S THE BUSINESS SHCM (IMP USA)

This was another class where first and second could swap places. Slightly smaller less heavy-set male with a super coat and in fabulous condition. He moved very well and gave first place a good challenge.

3<sup>rd</sup> Walter's GOYTRE SMOKIN GUN

Good Citizen Dog (3,1)

1<sup>st</sup> Tansley's BILYARA ICE MAIDEN

Well angulated male with a nice correct coat and lovely tail set. When he moved he showed great enthusiasm and a level topline. He has a well balanced head with nice ear set, good dark eye and well placed ears. He has ample coat of good quality.

2<sup>nd</sup> Brierley's BRAMBLES AZ AQUA FREEDOM P-BEG-EX

This male was more delicate in type with less masculine head. He was lacking in stop which made the head slightly less well balanced. Level topline held throughout. He moved well but needs to move in straighter lines to allow movement to be judged easier.
